### **Description of Services**

### **The Manor**

The Manor is a 21 bedroomed home situated in the village of Brampton, two miles from Huntingdon, for young adults with a range of physical disabilities.

We aim to provide a personal and empowering service to everyone who lives here. Individuals are supported to maximise and maintain a level of independence they're happy with.

We encourage people to play a full part in the life and the running of the service and offer the support of a well-trained and committed staff team. Volunteers, too, play an important role, supporting activities inside and outside the service.

### **What makes us special**

- Situated in pleasant grounds and easily accessible for local amenities.
- Activities include regular trips to the cinema, shops, theatre and live music.
- Well supported by the local community including our two neighbouring RAF bases who regularly fundraise for us and hold functions for service users in the mess.
- Independent living skills and social activities are supported and encouraged by our dedicated staff and volunteers.
- All service users are encouraged to join the consultation group, which plays an effective part in the running of The Manor.
- Most rooms are ensuite with telephone, internet and TV points.
- Sensory therapy is available.
- A weekly discussion group is run by a volunteer to talk about issues faced by service users and other interesting news stories.
- We have an adapted minibus and car for trips to town and to support service users to get to appointments.
